

Each year, thousands of migrants, the majority of which are from Niger, are repatriated from Algeria towards Niger within the framework of the agreement between the governments of Niger and Algeria. IOM, through the Migrant Response and Resource Mechanism (MRRM), provides humanitarian assistance for these migrants upon their arrival to Niger.
